**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-R**

**A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE ORDER OF THE DECLARATION OF DISASTER EXECUTED ON MARCH 17, 2020 BY THE MAYOR PURSUANT TO § 418.108, TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE, REGARDING THE COVID-19 A GLOBAL PANDEMIC**

**WHEREAS**, on the 18<sup>th</sup> Day of March 2020 the Mayor of Eagle Pass executed a Declaration of Disaster in order to activate the appropriate recovery and rehabilitation aspects of all applicable local or interjurisdictional emergency management plans and authorize the furnishing of assistance under said declaration; and

**WHEREAS**, § 418.108(b), Texas Government Code provides that the Declaration of Disaster may not be continued for a period of more than 7 days except with the consent of the City Council: and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that it is necessary and appropriate to continue with the extraordinary protective measures and efforts afforded by the Declaration of Disaster as executed by the Mayor on March 18, 2020

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAGLE PASS, TEXAS, as follows:**

Pursuant to § 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the Declaration of Disaster executed by Mayor Luis E. Sifuentes on March 18, 2020, is hereby renewed and will continue to be in full force and effect until the City of Eagle Pass deems it unnecessary to continue.
